This was the 53rd edition of IFCOMA Events in series.

Shri Sanjay Gupta, President IFCOMA expressed his sincere gratitude to Shri M Rafeeque Ahmed, Late Md Shamim Bhai, Md Aqeel ji & CLE for their continuous support. He informed the audience that in the Shoetech Vellore Show we have around 100 exhibitors with 120 stalls and we are sure that both exhibitors and Footwear manufacturers will benefit from Shoetech Vellore 22. He expressed confidence in achieving the export target of USD 10 billion and domestic industry target of USD 20 billion of leather, leather products and footwear set by the GOI for 2025-26, the manufacturers of Shoe components and accessories in India should plan & target approximate for USD 4 billion market in India. He said that Shoetech Vellore will play a vital role as this is a good opportunity to expand the business.

He made a fervent appeal to CLE & FDDI to conduct a nation-wide **Components** market survey to find out the total number of component manufacturers in India, their capacities, the quality and quantity of the materials to understand the exact dynamics of the sector. The outcome of the survey will give us actual data which will help us build the policy to drive the economic growth of the sector. The last such survey was done by CLE in 2004.

He stressed on taking initiative and striking Joint Ventures which is need of the hour to bring in new state of the art technologies from Italy, Spain, Taiwan and other such countries which are very strong on Footwear components. This will help us bring newer components to India and upgrade the quality of the existing components as well. We submit that CLE must take initiative to provide us a platform for joint ventures with the international players.

Shri Israr Ahmed Mecca felt it was proud moment for the Industry to host the Vellore Show. He expressed that the timings of the fair is immaculate. He was optimistic that after a lull due to the pandemic for the last couple of years the Industry is now ready to take a leap in terms of enhancing production capacities and its footprint across the world. He opined that the footwear sector needs to scale-up to meet the growing requirements. Considering this, the Council for Leather Exports has requested the Government to extend the Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) to the leather, leather products and footwear sector. PLI will be a game changer for the industry and will help in attracting domestic and overseas investments."

Shri Irshad Mecca said that the times have changed assets have become liabilities. Hence we need to work smarter. He stressed on the fact that the Footwear & Component Industry need to strengthen its production capacities as the World is looking at India with greater promise in future. He observed that we have to reduce the dependency on imports & improve our global market share.

Shri Yavar Dhala Vice President ISF and convener of Shoetech Vellore 2022 expressed vote of thanks to the entire team of IFCOMA & ISF. He expressed happiness to see Janab Hashim and Mr Rafeeque Ahmed gracing the event and sparing their valuable time. He said that in these exciting times for the industry, we are holding SHOETECH exhibitions across the country to showcase to the domestic market and the world our range of products. SHOETCH Vellore will have 100 exhibitors and 122 stalls and we expect around 1,000 visitors over these two days from within and outside India. International brands like Clarks, Marks & Spencers, Timberland and Kickers France are among the brands / buyers have confirmed that they will be attending the show. We expect SHOETECH to boost our efforts to make India the biggest sourcing hub in the world.

India is the second largest producer of footwear and leather garments in the world. The leather products and footwear industry have been seeing robust growth across the last two quarters as India continues its economic rise after the pandemic. This has come about due to reduced dependence on China, a global giant in the industry, the increasing productivity of Indian factories; the raw material that Indian has; the infrastructure that is being created and major investment by the Government in skilling programs.

With Government investment in world class institutions like the Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI), Footwear Design & Development Institute (FDDI) and Central Footwear Training Institute (CFTI), the proactive approach by the Private Sector and Councils like Council for Leather Exports (CLE) & Federation of Indian Export Organizations (FIEO), the industry looks to maintain its high levels of productivity and competitiveness.

The shoe component industry in India, in particular, is projected to grow at a rate of 15% this financial year and around 45% across the next three years. The turnover of the Indian footwear industry is expected to increase from USD 10 bn in 2021-22 to USD 18 bn by 2025-26 and the Production to from 2.6 billion pairs in 2021-22 to 4.55 billion pairs in 2025-26.

To harness this potential and exhibit the industry's abilities to the world market, the Indian Footwear Components Manufacturers Association (IFCOMA) and the Indian Shoe Federation (ISF) are organizing the next edition of their flagship exhibition, SHOETECH, on July 22nd and 23rd July '22 in Vellore at the Ramani Shankar Mahal.

More than 100 Exhibitors participated in the Shoetech Vellore and displayed various Footwear components, accessories & machinery. The above included specialized Finished leather, Buff leather, Soles (TPR/TPU/PU etc.) of the latest design, PU, Semi-PU, PVC, Machinery, Adhesive, Varnishes, Release Agents, Water based adhesives, Plastic shoe lasts, Insoles, toe-puff & Counters, Shank Boards, Technical textiles, Linings & Interlinings, Laminated fabric, EVA & PU foam, Moulded Socks, Comfort foam Insole, Heel grip, Non-woven fabrics, Velcro tapes, Shoe finishing Chemicals, Buckles, Metal fittings, Industrial Sewing Threads, Finishes & Chemicals, Packaging Boxes, Synthetic leather, fur, labels, Moulded counters, Shoe Machinery, Spares for Machinery, Knitted fabrics, Fusible Interlinings, etc.
